



ZEBA® IN CONTAINERS

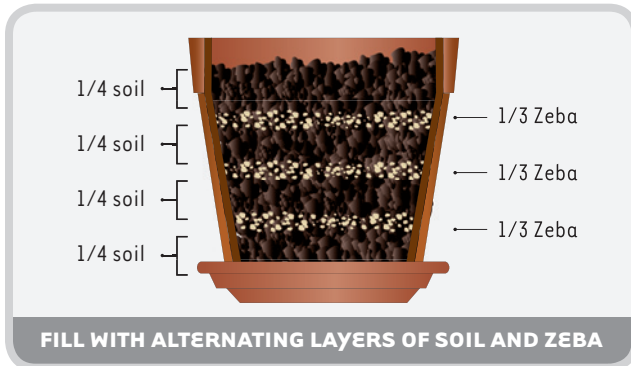
APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To plant with Zeba® in individual containers, follow these simple instructions.

1 FILLING THE CONTAINER

As you fill your container, alternate layers of soil and Zeba until the container is almost full. *Check the rate chart below to find the right amount of Zeba for your container size.*

Fill the container 1/4 full of soil and add 1/3 of the Zeba recommended in the chart below for your container size. Add another 1/4 of the soil to the container followed by another 1/3 of Zeba. Then, layer another 1/4 of the soil and the last 1/3 of the Zeba. Mix as instructed, before topping off your container with the remaining 1/3 of soil.



Large Containers

For large containers more than 12 or 14 inches deep, it is beneficial to keep the Zeba in the upper two thirds of the container. For large containers like this, fill the pot as in the diagram above. After setting the plants in the pot, add the last 1/3 of Zeba around the roots of the new plants.

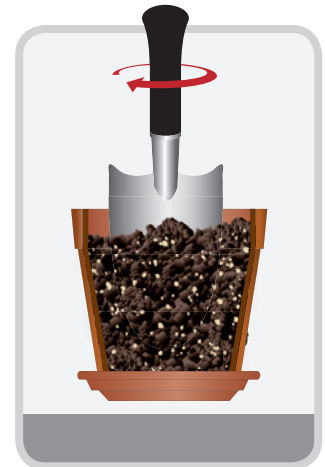
RATE CHART

Use 1 lb per cubic yard of soil, or 2.5 Tablespoons per cubic foot of soil.

Pot Size	Amount of Zeba®
4" pot	1/4 tsp.
#1	3/4 tsp.
#3	1 Tbsp.
#5	1 1/4 Tbsp.
#10	3 1/4 Tbsp.
#15	3 1/2 Tbsp.
#20	1/2 cup
#30	1 1/2 cups

2 BLENDING SOIL

Before adding your last layer of soil, it's important to blend the soil and Zeba layers so that Zeba is distributed evenly throughout your container. Do this by inserting a trowel into the pot and giving it a gentle twist while pulling it up out of the soil. Mixing once should be sufficient for small containers. However, you may need to do this a few times for larger containers.



3 WATERING

After planting, water thoroughly to begin hydrating the Zeba granules. Water again after 2-3 hours to ensure full hydration.

Note: As Zeba granules become hydrated, they are designed to stay put. This means their gentle swelling action will not disturb your plant or cause it to shift in its pot.

For Large Applications

Zeba granules can be mixed into bulk batches of soil mix. See chart for bulk rates.

When mixing in bulk, add the Zeba gradually to the soil mix and blend thoroughly after each application. The moisture in your soil mix will cause Zeba to immediately start hydrating. Adding Zeba gradually and mixing thoroughly as you go will prevent clumping as the Zeba hydrates.

Water thoroughly after planting to hydrate the Zeba granules. Water again 2-3 hours later to ensure full hydration.
